科目名稱：日常生活地理學研討 (Seminar on the Geography of Everyday Life)

## 一、教學目標

本課程旨在引介人文地理學和整個社會科學當中，一個快速興起的研究議題——日常生活地理學。這股「日常生活轉向」(the quotidian turn) 的理論觀點代表了地理學從後現代(post-modern)進入後人類(post-human)，從跨學科(inter-disciplinary)邁入後學科(post-disciplinary)時代的全新思維——一種「零碎整體化」(a fragmented totality)的反學科/反規訓(anti-disciplinary)觀點。這是對於現代資本主義社會，尤其是都市生活中的異化(alienation)和去異化(dealienation)，最迫切需要的辯證批判和人性反思。

## 二、課程設計

由於早期的日常生活理論探討多半是由歐陸的學者在不同的領域零星地發表，一直到近幾年才有部分英美的學者試圖整合這些離散的篇章。因此，本課程試圖兼顧讀本和原典之間的關聯性，在課程的初期先快速地回顧晚近學者整理的觀點，然後再深入閱讀幾本可以作為日常生活地理學基礎的經典著作。

希望這種結合系統性地閱讀經典理論文本和課堂上師生之間密集討論的研討方式，能夠幫助同學(以及我自己)練就回歸原點的學術馬步，以及奠基在這些理論觀點之上的全新視野。更期待透過師生的共同努力，將這些新的理論觀點活化成真實的生活實踐(包括學術研究在內)，為台灣長期以來積弱無力、貧乏困頓的人文地理學研究，注入一股新的活力。
